As the job posting states, this is a PART TIME position. The ideal candidate will have a flexible schedule and will be reasonably available when needed. Our work schedule is not based on standard office hours. Our schedule instead is determined by work demand, season of the year and weather. We often work long days when we are working. Some weeks the candidate may not be needed at all, the next week we may be working 40 hours per week.
